The Yarmouth Fuel Assistance Fund was established and is continued through the generous donations of Yarmouth residents and businesses and is administered through the Freeport / Yarmouth Regional General Assistance Office. Assistance is available to moderate-income to low-income households, with particular attention to those households not qualifying for other fuel assistance programs but still in need of assistance (for example households receiving unemployment benefits, households relying on minimum wage incomes, etc). For each new heating season, applicants are eligible for 100 gallons of heating fuel, with exceptions being made in emergency situations.

Our primary development is at Bartlett Circle in Yarmouth. It provides 28 affordable senior housing units, with another 28 units planned to be available in the future. Rents are based on income. Limits on income are \$26,000 for a single person and \$32,000 for a couple.
