**Food Pantry— Nancy Gorden**

The food pantry continues to serve between 30 to 38 patrons on a weekly basis while we receive an amazing outpouring of support from the community. We remain staffed by the small core of 3 to 4 volunteers who have been working both shifts for the most part since this crisis began. We have been lucky to also have a small cadre of additional folks who are helping rescue food from Hannaford's. We now have an ample supply of meat coming in on a weekly basis, along with bread, pastries, and some deli items. In addition, we support Lunch Crunch and its needs in serving those children who would get free and reduced lunches. Our basic needs continue to be jelly, rice, beans, baked beans and personal items.
